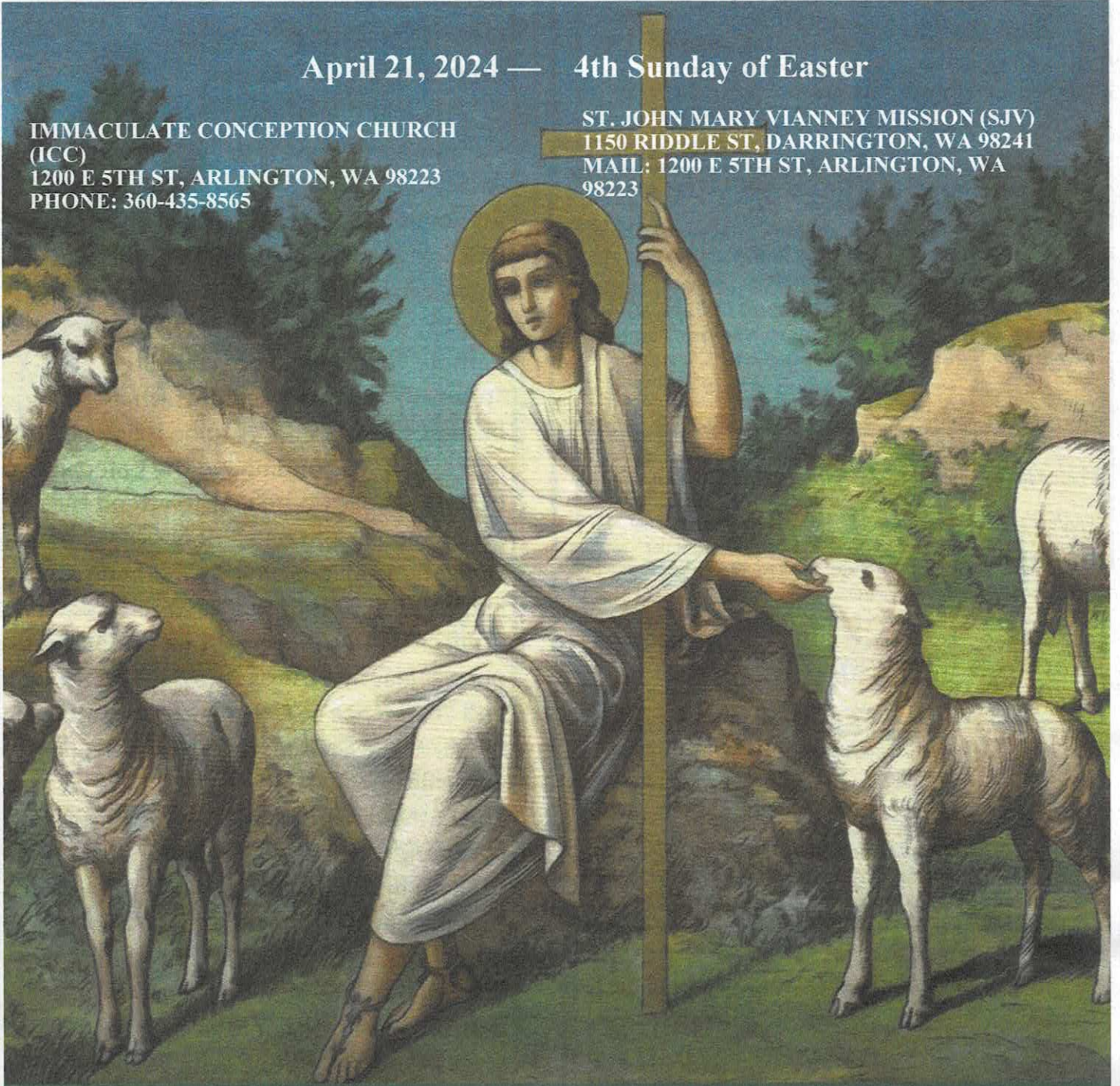

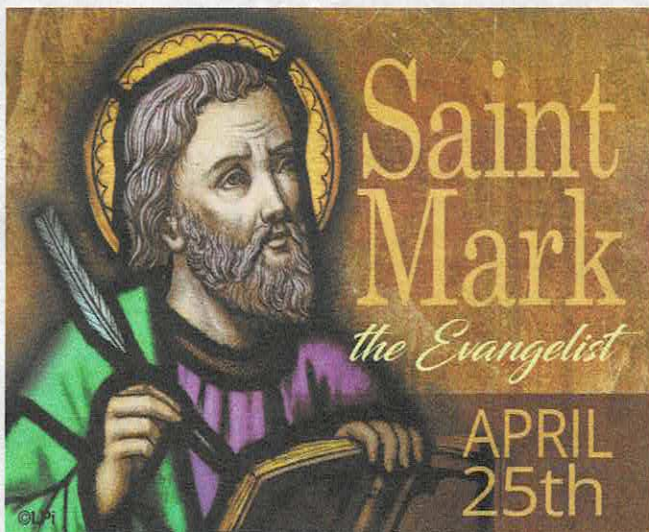

**Dear Parishioners of ICC and SJV,**



Happy Easter! Have you ever wondered what the minimum requirements to be considered a ‘practicing Catholic’? It’s always good to have a reminder! For the Church, this means that every baptized Catholic follow what are called the “precepts” of the Church, which are the base-line requirements to be followed. The precepts are as outlined in the Catechism of the Catholic Church, 1) To attend Mass every Sunday and on all Holy Days of Obligations 2) Receive Holy Communion at least once a year during Easter 3) Go to Confession to confess serious sins at least once a year 4) Observe the days of fasting and abstinence 5) Provide for the material needs of the Church as you are able, (see Catechism 2041-43).

The Catholic Church takes these precepts very seriously that every Catholic is bound to them under penalty of sin. This means that if a Catholic chooses not to observe one of the precepts without a legitimate reason, they have committed a grave sin that then must be confessed. These precepts should not be seen as mere “rules”, but as the essentials for every Catholic who desires to be close to God and live a right life.

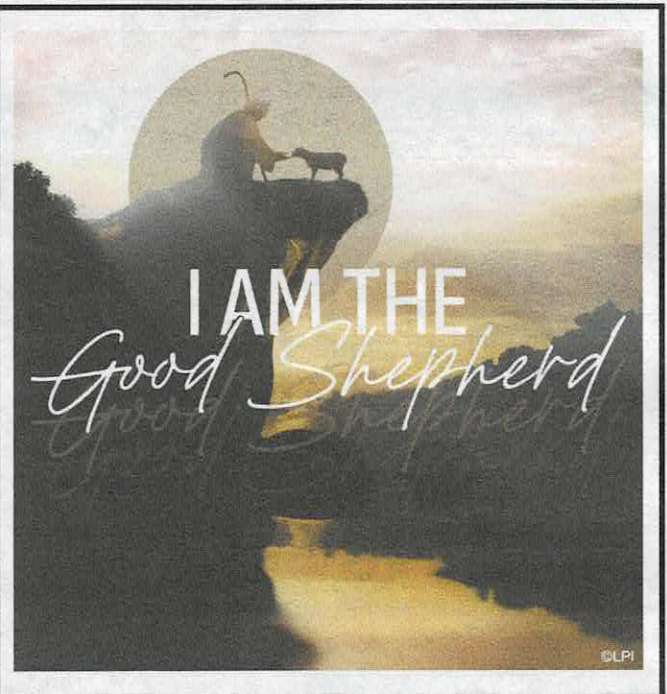
